Application for Admission to the Honors Program

Candidates for Honors in Hispanic Studies must have an excellent academic record and the ability to work independently. A candidate must take all his/her courses in their concentration program for a grade and receive no grade lower than "A" in those courses. Exceptions to this policy must be approved by the Department.

Candidates will apply for admission to the Honors Program during their sixth semester or, **at the latest, by the end of the third week of classes of their seventh semester**. The application must include a brief description of the thesis topic, which may be on an academic topic or a creative project, and the signature of the first reader. Upon admission, a second reader will be chosen by the student in consultation with the first reader.

Application Procedure: Please submit a complete application at the end of your sixth semester or by the end of the third week of your seventh semester to the Hispanic Studies Office, Room 117/118, Rochambeau House, 84 Prospect Street. The Department will determine whether the student merits admission to the Honors Program.
